

TODAY'S **REFLECTION**: "Do you think that I have come to establish peace on the earth? No, I tell you, but rather division." Luke 12:51 This passage seems contradictory to our Lord's mission as the Prince of Peace. But this just reinforces the truth about how difficult it is to be a follower of Christ and that nothing should separate us from our love of Christ The story of Saint Barbara illustrates how following Christ can cause division among families. As a result of Saint Barbara's conversion to Christianity, her own pagan father denounced her to the authorities who ordered him to kill her. He first tortured her and then killed her by beheading. To this day, some families, even Christian ones, are divided by denominational and theological differences. Even more severe is the division between Christians and those belonging to a different faith. So how can we have peace on earth? Let us follow the words of that beautiful song, "Let there be peace on earth." - Let there be peace on earth and let it begin with me. Let there be peace on earth, the peace that was meant to be. With God as our Father, brothers all are we. Let me walk with my brother in perfect harmony. Let this be my solemn vow to take each moment and live each moment in peace eternally. Let there be peace on earth and let begin it May the peace of Christ reign in our hearts.
