## REFLECTION FOR THE WEEK: WHO DO YOU SAY I AM?

In today's Gospel, Jesus asks Peter, "Who do you say that I am?" This is the most profound and intimate question any person can address to another. Responding to it calls for honesty, love and commitment.

This week, allow Jesus to ask you the same question: "Who do YOU say I am?" In your response (journal), make two columns. In one, write at least five responses. In the second, write what commitment your description of Jesus calls forth from you.

During your prayer time, imagine you are asking the same question to Jesus about yourself, and you say to Jesus, "who do you think I am?" Pray and reflect on how Jesus might answer you, and on how God might see you. What things in you need affirmation? What things in you need to be challenged?

Is there someone in your life you might welcome as dialogue partner in this exercise? God's blessings!
