REFLECTION 19TH SUNDAY Yr. A: THE STORMS OF LIFE

Like Peter and like Elijah, we all are on a journey crossing to the other side to safety. We are on a journey of life. Like them we have faith. Like them also we often lose our faith when we face some turbulence or when we find ourselves in the eye of the storm. In the Gospel narrative, we discover that amid the storm, when Peter's perspective changes he loses his focus and begins to go down. It is at this point that our Lord rescues him and calls him a man of little faith.

The message today gives us a perfect opportunity to access the measure of our faith in the face of various storms in our lives. Storms come in different shapes and sizes. Some could be facing health storms; some have marriage or relationship storms, some may be grappling with financial storms, for others it could be a job, career, or academic storms. All of them have one common characteristic; they do not last forever especially when we confront them with our faith perspective and keep our focus on Jesus. They come and go; the storm we have now is not the first and will not be last. But this too shall pass. God will see us through all storms of life. AMEN!
