Requirements for Godparents:

According to Canon Law, the law governing the Catholic Church:

- 1. Godparents should be at least 16 years old
- **2.** Godparents should be practicing Catholics and should have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Holy Eucharist and Confirmation. God parents are required to provide a certificate certifying that they have received the Sacrament of Confirmation. A copy of the certificate of Confirmation may be presented at the Baptism class, mailed to the Parish Office at 209 3rd Street, Jersey City, NJ 07302 or faxed (201) 333-1816. If this Certificate is not produced preceding the Baptism this person cannot serve as a Godparent. A marriage or baptism certificate with a notation of Confirmation is acceptable.
- 3. The Godparents current lifestyles should be in accord with the Catholic Faith.
- **4.** If Married the Godparent needs to be in a marriage considered valid in the Catholic Faith.
- **5.** At least one Catholic Godparent in good standing is required. If one Godparent is a baptized, practicing member of another Christian denomination, this person is referred to as a "Christian Witness," and his or her role in the Baptism ceremony is the same as the Catholic Godparent, the expectation is that the Christian Witness will be a Christian role model for the child.
