Y este rey se considera igual a todos los hombres, porque los reyes y cualquier ser humano nacen lo mismo que todos y mueren lo mismo que todos, como le sucede a los animales. Pero lo que hace a los seres humanos distintos en la vida y en la muerte es la sabiduría, por la que compartimos la vida misma de Dios.

Con la sabiduria se aprende a discernir lo que vale y lo que no vale en la vida. Hay personas que prefieren el oro, la plata y las piedras preciosas; el dinero y el poder. Quien elija la sabiduría habrá aprendido un sentido distinto de la vida y de la muerte; del dolor y del hambre; del sufrimiento y la desesperación. Con ella vienen riquezas, valoraciones y sentimientos que no se pueden comprar con todo el oro del mundo. Porque la verdadera sabiduría enseña a tener y vivir con dignidad.
