

REFLECTION FOR THE WEEK

Dear Family and Friends in Christ,

In the Gospel today, we read about Jesus meeting the first of His Apostles: Simon, James and John. These three men were fishermen, yet they found trouble as they could not catch fish. Jesus told them to come follow Him.

It is important to understand two things in this Gospel, the first being invitations and the second being walking together. Through our Baptism, we receive the invitation from God to become part of the church, our universal call to Holiness. "Many are called, but few are chosen" (Matthew 22:14).

There is a theme of walking together, or accompaniment that is present in this Gospel passage. Simon Peter, James, and John who are ordinary men are called to follow Jesus, to walk with Our Lord in his public ministry.

In today's world, each day of our life we are called to listen and walk with Jesus. Taking time to pray and reflect is ever essential towards our relationship with Christ. Jesus is there walking with us every step of the way, guiding us to salvation.
