Weekly Reflection

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we are in the season of Christmas, we recall the early days and humble beginnings of our Lord Jesus Christ. The Magi, the three Wise Men, went in search of the newborn King and used the Bethlehem star as a beacon. The three gifts of the Magi were Gold, Frankincense and Myrrh. It is important to highlight that the three gifts represent the three Divine Offices of Jesus: Priest, Prophet and King. They represent: Gold for a King, Frankincense representing Priest and Myrrh as Prophet. Throughout the church year, we focus on Jesus' early life and His ministry as an adult.

As the Religious Education program enters into the halfway mark of the Catechetical year, we continue the preparations for the Sacraments, of first Penance and Reconciliation, first Holy Communion and Confirmation for God's children. Students are learning and practicing their prayers, Our Father, Hail Mary and the Glory Be, along with the Act of Contrition. 1st Penance will take place in February 2023, 1st Holy Communion in May 2023 and Confirmation in July 2023.
