

REFLECTION FOR THE WEEK

Do not let your heart be troubled (John 14:1).

This week, Jesus tells us: Do not let your hearts be troubled; trust in God trust also in me. This is a call for us to allow our minds to rest in Him, place our trust in him, and do what He wants of us, and He will do the rest. We need to grow gradually in our trust of Him by taking our daily baby steps and God will do the rest. We learn to trust by trusting; a child that is afraid of falling as mom prompts him/her to walk, may never learn to walk.

Today Jesus says to us: do not let it trouble you. Come to me the way the truth and life. I will take care of you. Come and find in me a place for refuge.

Jesus cares for you. Learn to place all your concerns, all your needs, and everything in His hands, (second reading) for you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a people set apart. Do not let your heart be troubled. No matter what you go through, just focus on Jesus (not on the problem), and develop a strong trust in Him, through daily prayer and Sacraments, He will never leave you nor forsake you, but will always find a way to heal and sustain you.
