Reflexión

*El Amor de Dios a la Perfección de la Santísima Trinidad
Jn 3:16-18*

"Tanto amó Dios al mundo, que envió a su Hijo". El amor, por tanto, es envío. Y no es fácil. ¿Cómo pensar en lo impensable de un Dios venido en carne humana? Es un sentimiento algo más que lindo. Es heroico, porque lleva a acciones de sacrificio extremo. Esa manera de amar es reflejo de la manera de amar de Dios.

El amor es envío; implica también otras acciones no tan fáciles. El amor es poner un freno al enojo. Hay, sin duda, cosas ante las cuales hay que enojarse, como las injusticias. Tengamos que este tipo de amor impulsa a la acción. Pero ahora hablamos de las cosas pequeñas diarias de la casa, que simplemente reflejan modos de hacer las cosas y maneras de personalidad, que deberían estar controladas por el amor, como el de Dios, que pone freno al enojo.

El amor es trabajo. Trabajen por la perfección, dice Pablo a los corintios, pero no por la perfección de cosas perfectamente hechas, sino por la perfección de estar cerca de Dios en el amor.

El amor es camino. No se hace de "flechazo" como se dice normalmente, sino que se va construyendo al caminar, y al caminar con Dios. Dice Moisés: "Mira, Señor, si cuento con tu protección, venga mi Señor entre nosotros...".

El amor es más bien una acción preciosa, profunda, y comprometida. Es entrar en la propia vida del Dios que es relación: Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo.

Practice of Charity

God is relationship: The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit united in love and manifesting that love to humanity eternally. Made in the likeness of God, we also live in relationship, with God and with each other.

- ◆ We maintain rightly ordered relationships by strengthening our likeness to God. This Sunday, reflect on the attributes of the Father, Son, and Spirit. Imitate God the Creator by doing something to honor his creation — go for a walk and pick up any trash you see; volunteer at a humane society; pray to St. Francis for protection for all God's creatures.
- ◆ How might you restore justice in your community, even in a small way, like God the Son? Write or call your political representatives and encourage them to support policy that is just.
- ◆ How are you being called to teach and enlighten, like God the Spirit? Look for opportunities to support religious education in your parish.

Trinity Sunday

The dogma of faith which forms the object of the feast is this: There is one God and in this one God there are three Divine Persons; the Father is God, the Son is God, the Holy Spirit is God. Yet there are not three Gods, but one, eternal, incomprehensible God! The Father is not more God than the Son, neither is the Son more God than the Holy Spirit. The Father is the first Divine Person; the Son is the second Divine Person, begotten from the nature of the Father from eternity; the Holy Spirit is the third Divine Person, proceeding from the Father and the Son. No mortal can fully fathom this sublime truth. But I submit humbly and say: Lord, I believe, help my weak faith.
