Jesus makes explicit the connection between discipleship with him and service to, and leadership of, those who are lost and in need.

- Whenever the Church becomes more attentive to her well-being than to her mission to be Christ's body in the world, she herself becomes lost. Jesus sent the disciples to preach, to cure the sick, to drive out demons. In your time and place, how can you respond to your call to be a laborer for the harvest?
- Make a list of things you have received without cost and say a prayer of gratitude for them.
- Who are the troubled and abandoned of your place and time? The Christian heart cannot perceive these with indifference — let your heart be moved to an act of charity or assistance for one of them.
