Practice of Faith

Do we know yet what the kingdom of God is like? In parable after parable, with increasing urgency, Jesus impels us to understand where the path of faith is leading, and what obstacles we must overcome along our journey. In the parable of the wedding feast, he cautions: once we accept God's invitation into his kingdom (once we become Christians), we still have work to do. Like the underdressed guest, we can still be judged unfit for the banquet. Our limited view may yet get in our way.

- ◆ The complacency Jesus warns us about is defeated with deepened faith. The domestic church is where faith is organically grown and nurtured; if you do not already have one, start a family faith tradition such as a weekly Rosary or nightly prayer together.
- ◆ The first reading for this Sunday is frequently used at funerals. As November and the observance of the Commemoration of All of the Faithful Departed come closer, pray that those who have died may enter God's kingdom.
