Que Viva Cristo Rey



FOR THE SOULS IN PURGATORY

My Jesus, by the sorrows Thou didst suffer in Thine agony in the Garden, in Thy scourging and crowning with thorns, in the way to Calvary, in Thy crucifixion and death, have mercy on the souls in purgatory, and especially on those that are most forsaken; do Thou deliver them from the dire torments they endure; call them and admit them to Thy most sweet embrace in paradise.

Practice of Charity

The corporal works of mercy are the to-do list for Christians. Feed the hungry; clothe the naked; visit the sick and imprisoned, for there you will find Christ. In the words of the first reading, we know that Christ will bind up our injuries, rescue us and tend us, and that the nature of his sovereignty lies in this work. Until Christ returns, we take up this mission in his stead.

- ◆ Look into the volunteer possibilities at the hospitals and nursing homes in your city. Many people who are sick or frail in a nursing home would welcome a visit.
- ◆ How have you encountered Christ in the poor?
- ◆ How have you sought out the lost?
- ◆ In the Gospel reading, neither group recognized Christ in the poor. Why do you suppose the righteous continued to serve the needs of the poor?
