

Reflection for January 28, 2024:

"I should like you to be free of anxieties." 1 Cor 7:32

Chapter 7 of St. Paul's first letter to the Corinthians deals about married and unmarried life and the challenges, responsibilities and anxieties that each particular station in life brings. St Paul tells us to live as God calls us whether as a married or as a single person so that we could be free as much as possible from undue anxieties.

In St. Paul's another letter, Philippians 4:6-7, he says that the antidote for anxiety is prayer and to leave everything in the hands of God. St. Padre Pio has a very practical advice, "Pray, hope and don't worry." Of course, it is easier said than done but it is well worth applying in our everyday life.

REFLEXIONES DEL BOLETÍN DE CORRESPONSABILIDAD

28 de enero de 2024

40 Domingo del tiempo ordinario

"Hermanos: Lo que deseo es que estén libres de preocupaciones".— 1 Corintios 7:32

¿Qué tanta ansiedad traemos sobre nosotros mismos al preocuparnos constantemente acerca de no tener lo suficiente o de obtener más cosas? Dios no necesariamente te dará todo lo que deseas, pero sí te proporcionará todo lo que necesitas. Intente hacer esto - utilice la palabra "rezar" en lugar de la palabra "preocupar". Entonces pasará su tiempo rezando en lugar de preocupándose.

Practice of Hope

Jesus' expulsion of the demon is a powerful reminder of the truth of his teaching. We who believe in him commit ourselves to that same struggle against evil.

- ♦ In what ways do you yield to evil? How have you resisted evil? Pray for the courage to withstand whatever evils confront you.
- As Jesus exercised his teaching authority, people saw that he fulfilled God's promise to send a great prophet to speak on his behalf. Who speaks truly for God today? How can you too speak in ways that help others believe that God's goodness prevails over evil?
- For St. Paul, who thought Christ would come again at any moment, marriage was a distraction from serving God. Today we celebrate how marriage can strengthen commitment to the Lord. Reflect on your close relationships. Do they lead you toward or away from God?
