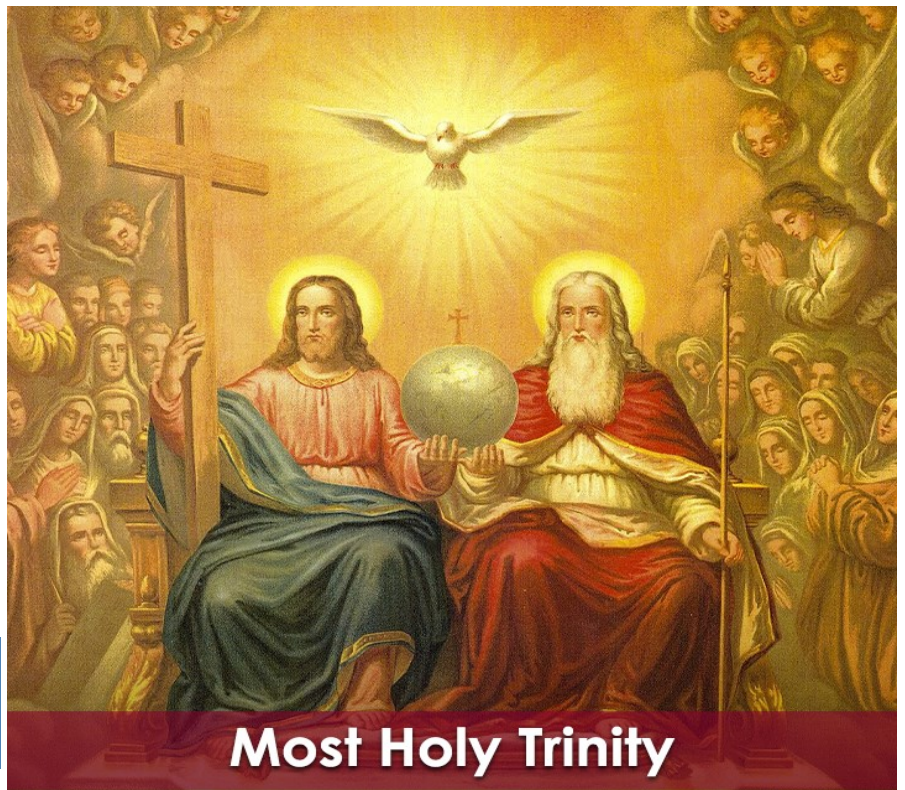

Practice of Charity

Human beings are made in the image and likeness of a God who is relationship — Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Though the word Trinity never appears in the Bible, we know it intimately through the example of the Father, Son, and Spirit. Today we celebrate this unity, which models for us how to create a community that reflects the love of God.

- ◆ As a Church, we pray the Nicene Creed. Look at it today and explore the Trinitarian language.
- ◆ Say a prayer of gratitude for someone who has embodied the call to “make disciples of all nations” (Matthew 28:19). How has this person shown you what it means to create, with God, a community that reflects the love of the Trinity?
- ◆ Today's reading from Paul's Letter to the Romans tells us that “we suffer with him [Christ] so that we may also be glorified with him” (Romans 8:17). Who is suffering in your community? How can you accompany them? Perhaps you will have an opportunity to share something with someone in need.
