Reflection for July 14, 2024:

"Whatever place does not welcome you or listen to you, leave there and shake the dust off your feet."

-Mk 6:11

This chapter starts with the story of Jesus being rejected in his hometown of Nazareth and continues with Jesus sending out his apostles to preach that the kingdom of God is here and he gave them authority to heal the sick. He instructed them to depend on God's providence and to proclaim the good news of God's kingdom but not force the people to believe. Let them return to God out of their own accord.

God loves us so much that He gave us free will to accept him or to reject him. Just as he sent out the apostles on a mission to win people back to God, so does he send us to continue that mission. Let us bring people back to God through our loving concern for each other, not by force or intimidation, but with tender loving care.

Jesus himself was rejected by his own people and he was deeply disappointed but he went on and continued to spread the Father's invitation to be with him on this earth and in the hereafter to everlasting life. Let us continue his mission to love and to bring love.

Religious Education 2024-2025

Registration is now open online for Religious Education (CCD) for students Grades 1 to High School for the 2024-2025 Catechetical Year here at St. Mary's Parish. Classes will be on Saturday mornings and will start in September. You can register online on the parish website. In person registration will take place at a special date during the summer. Religious Education for Adults, (RCIA) is also open on line at our parish website.

The RCIA program refers to the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults. It is designed to welcome adults into our Catholic faith. Preparation is a year long ongoing process every Sunday morning, culminating at the Easter Vigil Mass. The goal is to receive the Sacraments of Baptism (for non-Christians), Holy Eucharist, and Confirmation. The first RCIA class will start in September.

Educación Religiosa 2024-2025

Ya están abiertas las inscripciones en línea para Educación Religiosa (CCD) para estudiantes de Grado 1 a Secundaria para el curso 2024-2025. Año Catequético aquí en la Parroquia de St. Mary. Las clases serán los sábados por la mañana y comenzarán en septiembre. Puede registrarse en línea en el sitio web de la parroquia. La inscripción presencial se realizará en una fecha especial durante el verano.

La Educación Religiosa para Adultos (RICA) también está abierta en línea en el sitio web de nuestra parroquia. El programa RICA se refiere al Rito de Iniciación Cristiana de Adultos. Está diseñado para dar la bienvenida a los adultos a nuestra fe católica. La preparación dura un año proceso todos los domingos por la mañana, que culmina con la Misa de la Vigilia Pascual. El objetivo es recibir los Sacramentos del Bautismo (para los no cristianos), la Sagrada Eucaristía y la Confirmación. La primera clase de RICA comenzará en septiembre.
