Reflection

"Do you think that I have come to establish peace on the earth? No, I tell you, but rather division." Luke 12:51

Jesus' words in today's Gospel are very puzzling unless we put them in the context of the whole Gospel. After all, we know him as the Prince of Peace. He is saying that his mission is not to divide people, even family members, but he is saying that division will result from his ministry. Others will believe him wholeheartedly while some will not believe and even persecute those who do believe. For instance, converts from a different faith might find themselves rejected by their own family. Even Protestants who convert to Catholicism might find themselves out of favor with the rest of the family or vice versa. It is particularly difficult with children of mixed-faith parents. Sometimes, they end up not practicing any faith at all just to please Mom or Dad or to maintain peace in the family.

Jesus teaches us to love. It is the same message taught by other religions but why do we fight with each other in the name of our God? It is puzzling indeed. God, please give us wisdom, humility and understanding.


