Gaze with love upon Christ becoming present as the bread is broken by the priest. Receive his blessed Body and Blood knowing that he journeys with you and strengthens you until the end of time. Realize Christ's true presence this week:

- ◆ At Mass, close your eyes and imagine Jesus celebrating the Eucharist.
- ◆ Spend time in Eucharistic Adoration allowing Jesus to be present to your heart.
- ◆ Meditate on this Gospel and allow Jesus to appear to you on the road to Emmaus. Allow yourself to see Jesus as the disciples did.
