PENTECOSTES

Pentecostés consiste en que la Iglesia se transforma en la comunidad de Jesús. La presencia del Espíritu Santo se hace sentir en el compartir y el escuchar. La gran comunión viene a ser el gran horizonte, la nueva meta para la Iglesia, la comunidad de discípulos.

San Lucas nos señala con mucha claridad los signos de la presencia del Espíritu Santo. El viento, el fuego, los estruendos son el modo como el evangelio nos avisa que hay cambios reales al hacerse presente Dios en nuestro ambiente, en nuestra vida y en nuestras relaciones con los demás. La dispersión de los pueblos encuentra a Cristo el punto de partida y de llegada para la unidad y la concordia.

En la carta a los Gálatas San Pablo nos pide que no seamos ingenuos y pongamos adelante todo aquello que nos impide y estorba en la construcción del encuentro, la reconciliación, el perdón, la alegría y todo lo que nos da vida. Vivir y caminar en el Espíritu nos capacita para poner las cosas lo mas claramente posible enfrente de nosotros y distinguir bien entre los frutos de la iniquidad y los del Espíritu. No estamos solos en esta tarea tan vital. El Espíritu está con nosotros del mismo modo que estuvo con los que, en ese primer milagro de pentecostés, supieron hablar y supieron escuchar el lenguaje que supera cualquier barrera.

- ◆ In what corners of your heart is the breath of the Holy Spirit needed?
