Jesus promised his disciples that he would send them the Spirit of truth who would be their Teacher and Guide. Ask the Lord Jesus to renew in you the gift of the Holy Spirit who strengthens us in the seven-fold gifts of wisdom and understanding, right judgment and courage, knowledge and reverence, and holy fear in God's presence.

Practice of Charity

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity is a day to recall how we are invited to know, love, and serve God, who reveals the fullness of love to us and challenges us to be changed by it. In today's readings God is described to Moses as being slow to anger and abounding in love; St/ Paul then encourages the Corinthians to reconcile with one another. And, of course, the passage from John's Gospel roots our salvation in God's love for us.

- ◆ Think about how God loves us, and how that should inform our love for God and one another.
- ◆ Reflect on places and moments in your life when God's love has been especially clear to you.
- ◆ Consider times when someone demonstrated slowness to anger or abounding love, or the kind of encouraging care to which Paul exhorts the Corinthians. How did those experience make you feel? What can you imitate from them?
