Reflection: CORPUS CHRISTI

My dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The Holy Eucharist is a mystery as profound as the Holy Trinity and is Christ's greatest gift to us on our journey through life. Jesus commanded us to, "Do this in remembrance of me." As we celebrate Corpus Christi this weekend with a solemn procession, we come to honor Jesus with gratitude. How else do we respond to this great gift?

First, let us use the beautiful feast of Corpus Christi to examine our consciences, recommit ourselves to receiving the Holy Eucharist worthily, and show deep reverence for our Lord's Real Presence in the Blessed Sacrament—a mystery beautifully honored in the prayers and hymns of many saints.

Second, because Jesus gives Himself to us in the Eucharist and desires to remain present to us, we should make time to be present to Him in Eucharistic Adoration. Our parish offers Adoration on Mondays from 7:00–8:00 p.m., Wednesdays from 7:00–8:00 p.m., First Fridays from 7:00–8:30 p.m., and on First Saturdays from 9:00–10:30 a.m.

Please choose the times that work best for you and join your brothers and sisters in spending time with Jesus in His Eucharistic Presence. What better companion could we have on our pilgrim journey than Jesus in the Holy Eucharist?

Lastly, I encourage you to keep making Sunday Mass a priority. As you join us to celebrate the Holy Eucharist, let that Grace shine through your daily life.
